Sharing the Faith

The beautiful hymn named, “Spirit of God, Descend Upon My Heart” was authored by the Reverend George Croly in 1854, when Reverend Croly was seventy-four years old. Known for his high level of energy and forceful magnetic preaching, Croly, a Spirit-filled pastor in his faith, in addition to leading his own congregation in London, took it upon himself to lead the restoration and reopening of the nearby Saint Stephen’s Church, which had been closed for more than a century.

Even with just that brief biographical snippet, one could easily envision that George Croly was a person of faith who was engaged in many ways in promoting the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Indeed, in his last years, he himself prepared and published his own hymnal, “Psalms and Hymns for Public Worship,” in which the previously mentioned hymn, “Spirit of God, Descend Upon My Heart,” could be found under the section entitled, “Holiness Desired.” In the original four stanzas of this hymn, Croly makes a personal and moving appeal to us today.

In the first stanza, prompting us to change the focus of our lives toward holiness, Croly wrote, “to love Thee as I ought to love.” In the second stanza, to encourage dedicating one’s life to God, the words written were, “soul, heart, strength and mind,” which is a reference to the Shamah in the book of Deuteronomy, chapter 6 verse 5. In the third stanza, the words “teach me patience of unanswered prayer” were the author’s prompt to bolster strength of faith. And in the last stanza he wrote, “My heart an altar, and Thy love aflame,” as a pious call to the Holy Spirit to descend upon the heart, your heart and mine.

We recently celebrated Pentecost on Sunday, May 19th. We read the wondrous and miraculous story of the first Pentecost, with fiery tongues and the rushing Spiritual wind, and the disciples who were overcome in the upper room, and who then joined the crowds who were gathered in Jerusalem, and they were able to speak in the languages of all who were there that day. With all that Pentecost excitement, perhaps the question that we should all ask of God, is to have the Holy Spirit to descend on each of our hearts.

And so, in the Spirit of Pentecost, we will be working on just that, studying and learning and speaking about the manifestation of the Holy Spirit in our hearts for the next nine weeks. Please begin the process by opening your bibles to Galatians 5:22-23 and begin to contemplate, meditate on, and then embody the nine aspects of the Fruit of the Holy Spirit. I mean, since the Holy Spirit has already come, as Jesus promised it would, I think it’s time that we explore the benefits that the Spirit inspires in a deeper heartfelt way.

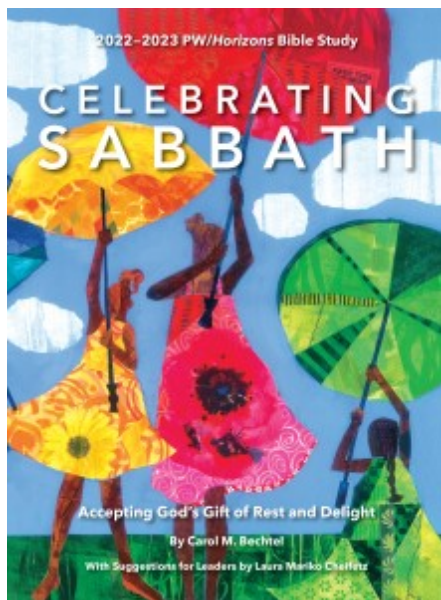


Men's Noon Lunch & Fellowship
