SHARING the FAITH

I've always felt that the ministry of John the Baptist was one of courage, insight, faith and sacrifice. A cousin to Jesus, born six months apart, it is only in Luke's gospel where we see how the two are connected in their infancy (Luke 1:24-38). Scripture gives no account of how they grew up together, but I must believe that they had to be close. The next thing we know is that John and Jesus are grown young men in their thirties and have arrived at the same time and place at the river Jordan. It is there that John the Baptist is doing what his name suggests for "all the people of Jerusalem," (Mark 1: 1-11). It is then and there when his cousin, Jesus, arrives and John, quoting the Prophet Isaiah proclaims, "Prepare the way of the Lord, make His paths straight...for I am not worthy to stoop down and untie the thong of His sandals. I baptize you with water, but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit (Mark 1: 3, 7b-8). So, in addition to being courageous, insightful, faithful and ready to sacrifice, John is a preparer. That's the message for this month's Sharing the Faith, to prepare the way!

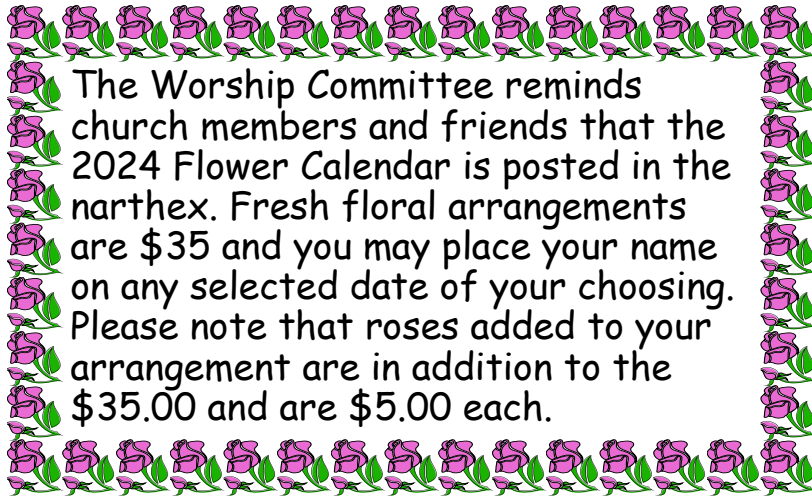

One way to prepare is for us all to think and pray about being a greater church. I hope the sermon series that has begun, and that I have named *Good to Great* will help us get ready for the next episode in our church. One way to do that is to come to know, contemplate, pray about and embody the *Great Ends of the Church*. Here they are:

The proclamation of the Gospel for the salvation of humankind;
The shelter, nurture, and spiritual fellowship of the children of God;
The maintenance of divine worship;
The preservation of the truth;
The promotion of social justice; and
The exhibition of the Kingdom of Heaven to the world.

It is my hope that as we talk about each one of the Great Ends, we will prepare Grace Church for more greatness, more faithfulness, more courage, and whatever sacrifice will be required in the future. Having these great ends in our minds and hearts will help your next pastor formulate with the congregation, your next straight path with Jesus. Prepare the way!

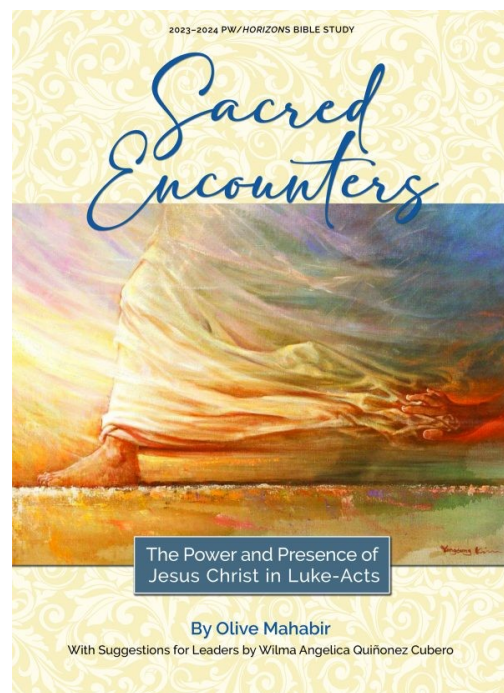
Men's Noon Lunch & Fellowship
