INTERIM MINISTRY

The Presbytery directs us to first call an interim minister before we begin our search for our new installed minister. One of the benefits of transitional/interim ministry is to provide the opportunity for our church to discern who we are as a congregation and to gain a clearer understanding of the attributes we are searching for in our future pastor. The interim pastor may challenge us to make some changes that we are not all comfortable making. It is very important for each of us to express our views and concerns. We need to each take an active role in prayerfully discerning who God is calling us to be as members of the body of Christ.

HURRICANE HELENE

Hurricane Helene made landfall late on September 26th near Perry, Florida, as the first known Category 4 storm to hit Florida's Big Bend region since records began in 1851. As of Friday evening, at least 40 deaths had been reported in multiple states. The impact of Helene will be felt across multiple states. With the storm surge, wind damage, and flooding, it is crucial to have the necessary resources to support the many communities that will be affected. Your generous gifts will bring hope and encouragement.

PDA is in communication with FLAPDAN (Florida PDA Network) and National VOAD (Voluntary Organizations Active In Disaster) to share information and coordinate resources as damage is assessed. PDA anticipates requests for National Response Team deployments and emergency grants in multiple presbyteries.

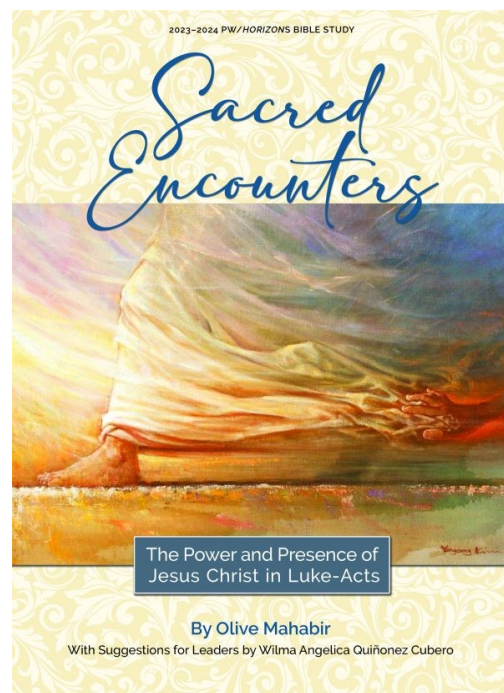
Men's Noon Lunch & Fellowship
