Dear Friends,

I am listening to Christmas music and swimming up from the depths of memory come the words to each tune, “glory to the newborn king”, “love and joy come to you... and God bless you and give you a happy new year.” Music’s power to evoke not just words but people singing “on Christmas day in the morning”, “that wondrous song of old, of angels bending near the earth to touch their harps of gold...”, “and heaven and nature sing.” God has yet again given-- a gift beyond reckoning—Peace on Earth, Good will to man! I pray you will not keep hidden the gift of God. In this new year, invite your friends over and share it and tell strangers and all those you meet that this gift is for them also. 
Men's Noon Lunch & Fellowship
